



NTA Fall Conference Golf Rules 2025

CHIMERA GOLF COURSE, HENDERSON NEVADA

The **most important rule of the Tournament** is “**HAVE FUN**”

1. Each Team will compete using a Scramble format. The team with the lowest score wins.

- a. A scramble means that all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker. Continue this way for each shot of every hole.
- b. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot.
- c. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard such as sand or rough you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
- d. This procedure is followed for putts as well. Pick the closest team member's ball to the hole and that is where **everyone** putts from.
- e. The team is cautioned not to make “tap” in putts until all team members have had the opportunity to attempt the team's original putt. IF YOU TAP IT IN – THAT BECOMES YOUR STROKE COUNT FOR THE HOLE.
- f. ONLY WOMEN AND MEN OVER 65 CAN HIT FROM THE FURTHEST FORWARD TEES (Ladies tees). This rule applies ONLY to NON-PAR 3 Holes. Otherwise, you are allowed to hit from any other tee color.
- g. **MULLIGANS:** Each player can purchase ONE or TWO mulligans to use for any **NON-PAR 3 TEE SHOT**. You can purchase Mulligans ON THE DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT at the registration table. Only one mulligan can be used per player, per hole and they MUST be used off the tee. You can give your mulligan(s) to a teammate.

Mulligans are \$10 each

- h. There are NO GIMMIE PUTTS.
- i. A buffet lunch will begin promptly in the bar in the clubhouse upon completion of play. Prizes will be awarded to the first and last place teams as well as the closest-to-the-pin contests and the long drive contests.
- j. If there is a dispute as to any rules herein presented or on the golf course, Rusty Shaffer is the final judge.

2. PAR 3 HOLE-IN-ONE PRIZES

- a. **GRAND PRIZE:** Hole 6 (par 3) has a hole-in-one grand prize of a \$10,000 golf cart. There are only two tee boxes to hit from – MEN must hit from the 165-yard tee box and women must hit from the 150-yard tee box. There are no other tee boxes on this hole. NO MULLIGANS CAN BE USED ON THE PAR 3 HOLES.
 - b. **OTHER PAR 3 HOLE PRIZES:** Hole 4, 12, 17 (par 3's) have hole-in-one prizes valued at \$500. Men must hit from 130-yard tee box and women from the 115-yard tee box.
3. On **HOLE 11**, there is a men's and women's long drive contest. Longest drive at the end of the day for each wins a prize.
 4. On **HOLE 17**, there is also a closest-to-the-pin contest for men and women. Each closest to the pin contest at the end of the day wins a prize.
